



RoHS Statement

In February 2003, the European Union issued Directive 2002/95/EC regarding the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS). The RoHS directive states that as of July 1, 2006, electrical and electronic equipment manufacturers must eliminate the use of all lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) and polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) in products sold in the European Union (EU).



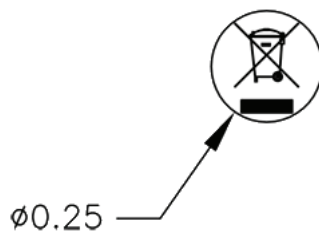
**Example of
Lead-Free Symbol**

Performance Technologies products compliant with RoHS are marked with a lead-free symbol on the serial number label. Products that do not have this symbol on the serial label must be assumed to be non-compliant.

Although Performance Technologies has taken commercially reasonable measures to assure certified compliant products do not contain amounts of the banned substances that exceed the directive's allowable percentages of each homogeneous material, the company's sole obligation in the event certified products are found to be non-compliant is to replace non-compliant products with compliant products or, at Performance Technologies' sole option, to accept return of the products and refund the purchase price.

WEEE Statement

Directive 2002/96/EC Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (the "WEEE Directive") encourages the proper repair, upgrading, reuse, or disassembly and recycling of certain categories of electronic equipment.

Performance Technologies products that fall under the WEEE Directive are marked with the proper symbol as provided in the WEEE Directive.

End-user buyers of Performance Technologies products shipped to the EU are, as the company's business-to-business customers, the responsible party for WEEE directive compliance. Performance Technologies encourages end-user buyers of the company's products to locate proper waste disposal companies within their countries.

OEM buyers of Performance Technologies products or their end-user customers (depending on the agreements entered into between them) are the responsible parties for the disposal of Performance Technologies products per the WEEE directive.

Except for this notification and the proper marking of products with the appropriate symbol, Performance Technologies disclaims responsibility for the disposal of its products per the WEEE directive.
